INTRODUCTION

The uncertainty caused by the USA's declared war on the world continues to unfold. Travel to the USA from Canada has dropped by 23% thus far, as millions of Canadians change travel plans. They're still travelling, just not to the USA as much. This affects map sales for ITMB, as we see a noticeable decline in requests for maps of American destinations. Economically, tariffs are starting to hit all corners of the world, of which I'll say more further into this newsletter. I do not know how individuals in other countries are reacting to American hostility, but I imagine that hard feelings are going to solidify in many countries, Russia, and North Korea excepted. The world is entering a period of great instability, with anti-government protests in Serbia and Hungary, and Georgia, and all over the USA. All ITMB can do is watch helplessly as events unfold and hope that travel will not be impacted too seriously.

NEW TITLES

As spring arrives, so do new map titles! This month, we welcome **Angola**, **Peaks of the Balkans**, **Chicago** (with a brand new state map of **Illinois**), **Costa Rica**, **Finland**, **Helsinki and Southern Finland**, **Pakistan**, and our famous regional map for **Vietnam**, **Laos and Cambodia**. This last title was supposed to have been released last January, but due to a printing error, one side was badly out of register, so the printer had to re-do the print run. Anyway, we are very happy to see this important map back in print. Details for ordering are noted in the **NEW RELEASES** section, below. Another half dozen new maps will be released next month!

WORLD WAR 3 HAS NOW STARTED

By now, everyone has realized that the world is engaged in an enormous economic war. Few understand its implications. To punish those countries having a trade deficit with the USA, Trump has declared ruinous tariffs on all goods entering the USA from 185 countries, most of which are impoverished states like Cambodia and Myanmar. The actual prices might not rise by 20%, because most maps are sold to distributors/retailers at a trade discount, but prices will rise, to the detriment of individual American customers. At the moment, Canada is not included in these massive tax increases, so maps from ITMB are not affected, and prices will not change, but virtually every other travel map will see significant price hikes.

Remember, this could change tomorrow because Trump is notorious for changing his mind on a moment's notice! Needless to say, this punitive tax applies only to the USA. ITMB customers in Canada, Europe, and around the world (apart from the USA and its possessions) will see no price increases. We regret the fact that the American government is taxing its citizens so heavily, but there is madness afoot in the USA these days, and we all have to sit tight and wait for this era to end. Until Americans rise up in their millions and replace this corrupt governance, the madness will continue. Sorry to have to be blunt, but only Americans can modify the current direction of the USA. We are in uncharted waters in the middle of a hurricane. SOS!!!

POSTMASTER GENERAL

British North America, and later on, the USA, has always had a Postmaster General managing the movement of mail – until Monday, March 24th, when the current incumbent suddenly and immediately resigned and vacated his office with no explanation as to why he was leaving. As chaotic situations seem commonplace in today's USA, this departure has not resulted in much media coverage, but the post is crucially important. The British set up the postal system that still operates today in the USA, and Benjamin Franklin was the most famous Postmaster General for all 17 American colonies. Throughout the American Revolution, the mails continued to flow, enabling thousands of conversations to occur. After 1783, Franklin became the Postmaster General of the 13 rebellious colonies, and it is largely thanks to him that postal unity enabled the creation of the USA. What is going to happen now? For the first time in 400 years of North American history, there is no Postmaster General to act as a sort of glue to hold the USA together in a non-partisan way. A sign of the times!

MAP TOWN IN CALGARY CLOSES ITS DOORS

I have recently received an email from Terry, the owner of Map Town, in Calgary, Alberta, advising me that he is vacating his commercial premises on April 23rd and moving on-line. Map Town has been a staple of downtown Calgary for as long as I can remember, occupying a very large ground-floor space and creating large-scale maps for the oil industry (which used to be huge in Calgary). Alas, Map Town did not move with the times as the downtown area became a wasteland of empty office towers and shoppers abandoned it for suburban malls with ample parking. While Map Town carried a wide range of international travel maps, its market was the oil industry, which used to number in the hundreds of companies, but is now much smaller in number, thanks to consolidations. Terry hopes that his client base will follow him into electronic obscurity, but I've seen this scenario too many times in too many cities around North America to believe that individuals will follow him. After all, the reason that he is shutting down is because his walk-in trade has moved elsewhere, such as to Amazon.ca. I'm sorry to see Map Town disappear, as I was to see Mapworld Services disappear, and a dozen other stores. This leaves three dedicated map stores and one travel store left in all of Canada – ITMB in Vancouver, World of Maps in Ottawa, Aux Quatre Points in Montreal, and Ulysses Books, also in Montreal. Fortunately, there are numerous retailers still stocking maps, and very fortunately, there is a good, steady base of customers who prefer paper maps over electronic gadgets, so we carry on. Best wishes to Terry and I hope that your on-line business flourishes.

WHAT IS HAPPENING AT ITMB?

No, nothing bad is happening. Lan and her staff are hard at work updating artwork and sending it to our printers. At the moment, we have 22 titles at press, some of them for titles that we have already run out of inventory, others for titles that are selling quickly, and we want to keep stock on hand. There are, however, a growing number of map titles that are nice to have, but sell rather slowly. Much though we would prefer to keep all titles in print at all times, updating can take weeks of time to prepare for printing and the printing process also takes a longish time to complete. We have neither the staff nor the money to do everything as fast as we would like, for which I apologize. Creating accurate and up-to-date maps is a time-consuming task. We do our best to come close to the 'perfect' map (which I think is impossible to attain), but we also have to accept that we live in an imperfect world that includes countries and cities for which there is very little market demand, at least as of this point in time. We do not have enough dedicated cartographers to update 50 different titles simultaneously, sad to say, and yet we have that number queued up awaiting their turn at being updated. We have to concentrate on ensuring that popular travel destinations, like Italy and Spain, receive priority attention. This means that slower-selling titles sometimes have to wait until we have time to concentrate on them. They will all get done; just not as quickly as we would like. We still publish 6 or 7 new titles each month; just check out the New Releases, below.

ITMB is a prolific publisher of travel maps and demand remains strong for what we produce. However, I fear that the world is entering a phase of existence where it will be more difficult, and more expensive, to travel. I am afraid that Trump's tariffs will sour the travelling people of the world to boycott American cruise lines, American web sites promoting travel, and American firms in the travel industry, such as Expedia. There are already signs that this is happening. If what I'm seeing is a trend, downward sales will destroy American dominance of the travel market.

After a long period of isolation, the country now welcomes tourists, and is investing in improved infrastructure to make it easier to travel around this vast country. New resort hotels are attracting tourists to beach hotels along the coast and inland hotels are being upgraded. The road network is improving, but still is a work in progress. The USA is building a new trans-Africa railway, but its future is uncertain due to Trump's cutbacks. The map includes a detailed inset map of Luanda, the capital, and a list of Top Attractions. Angola is still a developing country, so travel here is more adventuresome than in Kenya or Morocco, but it is growing in popularity. **AVAILABLE**

ITMB publishes a travel map for the region, but has developed a market for a more specific map focusing on mountain hiking routes through the Balkans. This is one of the few such areas left in Europe and appeals to those energetic enough to enjoy walking through alpine meadows. There are several routes in Albania and Montenegro, and we have marked such trails on our map, along with overnight huts. The concept is spreading, so Side 2 focusses on the southwestern Balkan region, where long-distance trails are being developed. **AVAILABLE**

It is also the start (or the finish) of famed Route 66, the first paved highway to the Pacific. Side 1 covers the city from the convention centre north to Wrigleyville and from the lakefront west to Western Avenue, with a large inset of Greater Chicago and another of Oak Park (famous for being the home of Frank Lloyd Wright). Side 2 is a brand new map for ITMB, being of the great state of Illinois, of which Chicago is a small part. This side traces Route 66 southwest from its origins in downtown Chicago to somewhat beyond St. Louis, where the national highway continues into Missouri. This map starts on Wisconsin in the north, at Minneapolis, and continues south to western Kentucky, ending at Nashville, Tennessee and is loaded with touristic attractions that are sure to delight visitors. Naturally, we have kept it up to date. Side 1 concentrates on the southern portion of the country, and includes a detailed map of San Jose, the capital. Side 2 concentrates on the more mountainous northern portion and the coastal beaches on the Pacific Ocean. As a country to visit, CR offers a lot – pristine beaches, lush rainforests, interesting volcanoes, and a lifestyle that is pleasant and safe. **AVAILABLE**

The country faces west and welcomes visitors. It is also a very large country, so the map is divided into a north/south configuration. Side 1 shows the southern portion fronting on to the Sea of Bothnia and the strait facing Estonia. The capital, Helsinki, and the western port city of Tartu are shown, as well as ferry routes connecting the country to port cities along the Baltic Sea. This is a country of lakes, which are clearly shown, as are the rail routes joining communities and the highly-developed road network. Side 2 concentrates on the more northerly portions, all the way to Lapland in the far north. Border crossings to Russia are shown, but they are closed due to Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Helsinki & Southern Finland Travel Reference Map 3rd Ed. 2025 on waterproof paper 1:10,000/1:750,000 ISBN 9781771293457 UPC 817712934574 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP9.95 — Co-incidentally, ITMB's map of Helsinki arrived at the same time as the map of Finland. There wasn't room in the country map to include the capital city, so a separate map is required. Helsinki is very focused on the water, being located on a peninsula at the southern tip of Finland. The heart of the city is located just south of the railway station and is full of interesting buildings. This is a city that is easy to get around, thanks to its excellent network of trams, all of which are clearly shown on our map. Naturally, ferry terminals are also shown, although the ones to Saint Petersburg are closed for now. Side 2 covers southern Finland, which is the most visited part of the country, showing ferry routes to Estonia and Sweden, as well as to the very scenic Aland Islands. **AVAILABLE**

Relations between India and Pakistan have been testy ever since, although the passage of time has made both countries aware that they need each other. That said, Pakistan is a lovely country to visit and explore. Side 1 concentrates on the southern portion of the country and includes an inset of the main city, Karachi. The south also shares long border areas with Iran, Afghanistan, and India, which are included. We have updated the road network to show recently completed motorway-like roads. The northern portion fills Side 2, continuing the long border with Afghanistan and the ill-defined borders with China and India. There is much to see in this part of Pakistan, such as the city of Quetta in the west, Islamabad, the capital, ancient Lahore, and the Hunza Valley, all of which are noted in our Top Attractions list. The north is truly adventuresome travel, and it is possible to drive the fabulous Karakoram Highway towards China, one of the most amazing road trips anywhere. However, although the contested Kashmir region is shown on the map (because it's there), visitors need to be aware that this is a volatile part of the world and should avoid it. This is a country that is much less visited than it should be. **AVAILABLE**

After WW2, it became Cambodia, Laos, and Vietnam (admittedly, after much turmoil). The three countries now constitute the heart of South East Asia and are very friendly towards tourism, so much so that all three countries co-operate closely. Cambodia, of course, has Siem Riep and the fabulous temples of Angor, while Laos has its pastoral countryside, and Vietnam its bustling cities. Side 1 shows the southern portion, dominated by the delta of the Mekong River. An inset of the Saigon portion of Ho Chi Minh City is included. The second side continues north to the Chinese border, and shows the growing network of motorways emanating from Hanoi and leading to China as well as to the south. A detailed inset of Hanoi's old town is included. **AVAILABLE**

Easily reachable from either country, it is one of those off-the-beaten-track that make Europe unique. The reverse side concentrates on the entire Pyrenees mountain chain from both the French and the Spanish points of view, from Bayonne in the west to Perpignan in the east. Did you know that Andorra has a tiny enclave surrounded by France? Look for Llivia, west of Mont-Louis! AVAILABLE

The southern island of Viti Levu is more popular with tourists, but the more northerly island of Vanua Levu is more relaxing. The second side shows the islands of Tonga. This is less visited than Fiji, just to its west, and consists of dozens of islands and many resort hotels. The capital of Nuku'alofa is small enough to walk everywhere and is the point of embarkation for most of the other islands. The 2nd side is a new map for us, covering the western half of Switzerland as far as Basle and Luzern, concentrating on the rail network as well as the roads. For example, it shows the rail line to Zermatt, at the base of the Matterhorn. This is a beautiful part of the world to explore! AVAILABLE
